Overview

Dr. Pullagura has enriched his expertise through training at CEMAST, Mumbai, for Endoscopy. The doctor holds a lifetime membership in the Association of Surgeons of India (ASI). In terms of work experience, Dr. Pullagura served as a Senior Resident as well as a General and Laparoscopic Surgeon in various medical teaching colleges and hospitals in Bangalore. Currently, he holds the position of Associate Consultant in the Department of General Surgery at Manipal Hospitals Jayanagar and Manipal Begur Clinic. Apart from his medical career, Dr. Rajeev has also contributed to the medical field through his presentations and published works in journals.
