Dr. Suraj Manjunath is a highly skilled consultant in the Surgical Oncology Department at Manipal Hospitals, located in Miller's Road, Bengaluru. He specialises in various aspects of microsurgery, including Enhanced Recovery After Surgery (ERAS) protocols, breast cancer surgery utilising techniques such as Sentinel Node Techniques, Oncoplasty, and Organ Conservation, as well as minimally invasive surgery for gastrointestinal malignancies. Dr. Manjunath's contributions to the field of surgical oncology have been recognised internationally. He received the prestigious International Career Development Award from the Surgical Oncology Society in the United States, becoming the first individual from India to be honoured with this distinction. Furthermore, he played a pivotal role in establishing one of the initial MCh Surgical Oncology Training Programs. He founded and developed the Surgical Oncology Department at St. John's Medical College & Hospital, leaving a lasting impact on the institution's growth. His postdoctoral MCh in surgical oncology from the Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology also earned him a gold medal. Throughout his career, Dr. Manjunath has undergone training at renowned institutions both in India and overseas, showcasing his commitment to staying at the forefront of surgical oncology advancements. Notably, he completed a fellowship in surgical oncology and minimally invasive surgery at Harper University Hospital in Michigan, Detroit, in 2011. He further honed his expertise through a fellowship at the MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas, focusing on upper gastrointestinal surgical oncology in 2014. Therefore, he is considered to be the top surgical oncologist in Bangalore. Dr. Suraj Manjunath's professional affiliations reflect his dedication to the field of surgical oncology. He is a life member of esteemed organisations such as the Association of Surgical Oncology of India, the Bangalore Surgical Gastroenterology Group, and the Society for Peritoneal Malignancies in India. These memberships serve as a testament to his active involvement in the surgical oncology community, fostering collaboration and knowledge exchange. With his extensive training, expertise in various surgical techniques, and active engagement in professional organizations, Dr. Suraj Manjunath has established himself as a leading figure in the field of surgical oncology.
